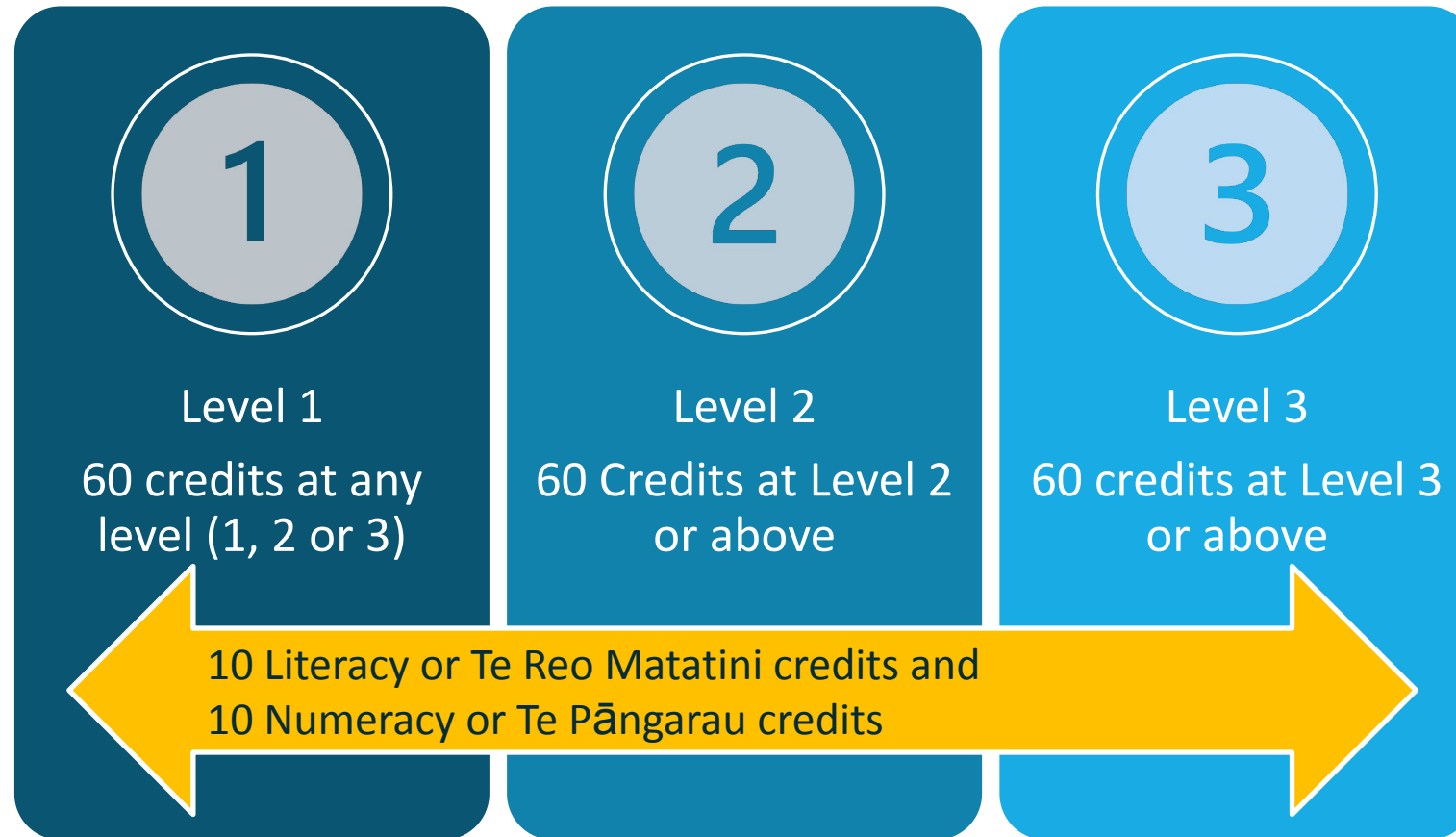

National Certificate of Educational Achievement

To gain NCEA Level 1 your son needs;

- 60 credits at NCEA Level 1 or above.
- Pass the Numeracy and Literacy Co-Requisite.
 - Or pass 10 Literacy and 10 Numeracy credits from specific Level 1 standards (during the transition period)

NCEA Level 1, 2 and 3



Internal and External Assessment



- An **Internally Assessed Standard (Int)** means the assessment is carried out in school.
 - Internal Assessments are marked & moderated by teachers at Rosmini College and then checked by NZQA.
- An **Externally Assessed Standard (Ext)** means the assessment is carried out by an examination at the end of the year or through a **Common Assessment Activity (CAA)** or work completed during the year submitted as a portfolio.
 - External assessments are set and marked by NZQA.

Co-Requisite Literacy and Numeracy



To ensure students have foundational skills for further education, training and employment.

A package of 20 Achieved level only credits - students will need these as a requirement to obtain their Level 1, 2 and 3 NCEA certificates.

- 10 Numeracy
- 5 Reading and 5 Writing credits

Students only have to achieve the **Corequisite package ONCE** but get multiple opportunities to do so. (Two per year digital testing). **NB: Year 10s 2026 - sit these in week 8 Term 3.**

Co-Requisite Literacy and Numeracy



In 2024, the 20-credit co-requisite became mandatory for the awarding of any NCEA qualification, and credits used towards the 20-credit co-requisite cannot be used towards the 60-credit NCEA qualification.

Additional assessment standards and assessment approaches are available for learners during this period.

Level 1 Students 2026 and 2027



Rosmini Level 1 students in 2024 & 2025 have sat the **NEW** Level 1 achievement standards. Fewer but more meaningful assessments.

These courses provide the broad, foundational knowledge needed for specialist courses in NCEA Level 2 and 3.

All students in Years 10-12 in 2027 will continue with the NCEA qualification until it changes.

Course Example – English Level 1



11ENG - English

Descriptor

Our Level 1 English course provides opportunities for ākonga to use literature and language to explore self, society and the wider world. Whanaungatanga, kaitiakitanga, manaakitanga are at the heart of our subject.

- 1.1 Demonstrate understanding of how context shapes verbal language use. **Internal 5 credits**
- 1.3 Demonstrate understanding of specific aspects of studied texts. **Internal 5 credits**
- 1.4 Demonstrate understanding of specific aspects of unfamiliar texts. **External 5 credits**

NB: Writing and reading conventions woven through the course.

Endorsement – Subject



- To gain a **Subject Endorsement** you need to gain **14 credits** at **Achieved or higher** within one subject for that year.
- 3 of the 14 credits must come from internally assessed standards and 3 of the 14 credits must come from externally assessed standards.

Endorsement – NCEA Overall



- To gain an NCEA Merit Endorsement you need to gain 50 of your 60 credits at Merit level or higher.
- To gain an NCEA Excellence Endorsement you needs to gain 50 of your 60 credits at Excellence.

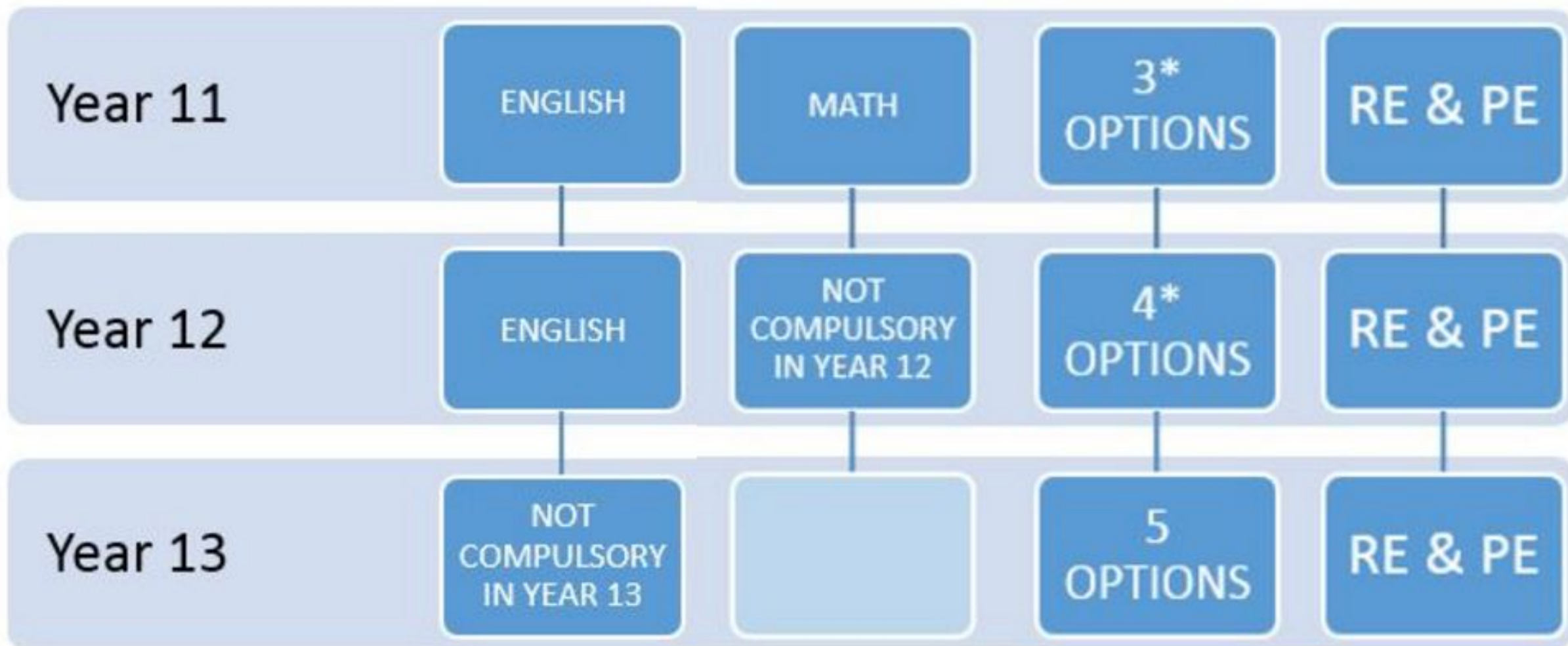

HoD: Mr J MacIntyre

In Physical Education, the focus is on the well-being of the students themselves, of other people, and of society through learning in health-related and movement contexts.

Four underlying and interdependent concepts are at the heart of this learning area:

- **Hauora** – a Māori philosophy of well-being that includes the dimensions taha wairua, taha hinengaro, taha tinana, and taha whānau, each one influencing and supporting the others.
- **Attitudes and values** – a positive, responsible attitude on the part of students to their own well-being; respect, care, and concern for other people and the environment; and a sense of social justice.
- The **socio-ecological perspective** – a way of viewing and understanding the interrelationships that exist between the individual, others, and society.
- **Health promotion** – a process that helps to develop and maintain supportive physical and emotional environments and that involves students in personal and collective action.

Every Student Takes Six Subjects

Level 1 (Year 11)

- Students are able to select **THREE** subjects and 1 backup/ reserve subject.
- RE/ PE, English and Mathematics are compulsory and will be automatically selected.

Level 2 (Year 12)

- Students are able to select **FOUR** subjects and 1 backup/ reserve subject.
- RE/PE and English are compulsory and will be automatically selected.
- Mathematics is not compulsory but is recommended.

Level 3 (Year 13)

All Year 13 students are required to study **FIVE** subjects as well as RE/PE.
